- 1. Jersey College has signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement. Jersey College has used or intends to use no less than 50 percent of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
- 2. The total amount of funds Jersey College has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students is \$2,55\B2.
- 3. The total amount of Emergency Financial Aid Grants distributed to students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act as of the date of this report is \$2,542,\mathbb{4}1.30.
