

**NOTICE OF PRE-DISPUTE ARBITRATION AGREEMENT
AND CLASS ACTION WAIVER FOR DISPUTES**

In accordance with the disclosure and other obligations set forth in the U.S. Code of Federal Regulations Title 34, Chapter VI, Sections 668.41 and 685.304, each student is notified that the Enrollment Agreement contains a pre-dispute arbitration agreement and a class action waiver. Agreeing to these conditions are prerequisites to enrolling at Jersey College. The pre-dispute arbitration agreement and class action waiver provide the following:

Arbitration

I agree that any dispute or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement or, absent such agreement, my enrollment or attendance at Jersey College, whether such dispute arises before, during, or after my attendance and whether the dispute is based on contract, tort, statute (including the Federal Arbitration Act (FAA)), or otherwise, shall be referred to and resolved by arbitration. If a claim or defense is frivolous or wrongfully intended to oppress the other party, the arbitrator may award sanctions. The Federal Arbitration Act (FAA) shall otherwise govern this arbitration provision. This arbitration provision shall survive the termination of my relationship with Jersey College.
